New Year's Resolutions at the Giving Nest

We wish everyone a happy and healthy new year! The arrival of 2026 will be celebrated at the Giving Nest with noisemakers and confetti. Each class is challenged with a new skill to accomplish in 2026

The <u>Chickadees</u> (2 ½ year old's) will begin to learn how to unpack their own backpacks. Upon arrival, with guidance from the teachers, the children will learn where the backpack is hung up and where to put their folder. After a few times it's amazing to see how quickly the children learn how to do this themselves.

The <u>Ducklings</u> (3 to 4-year old's) will begin getting their own coats at the end of the day and putting them on without any help. They will use the preschool method of laying the coats on the ground and putting their arms in the sleeves and flipping the coats over their heads (flip-flop over the top!).

The <u>Bluebirds and Cardinals</u> (4 to 5-year old's) will begin zippering, buttoning and/or snapping their own coats and putting on their hats and gloves all by themselves.
