To end our artist unit the children will visit 4 stations that allow them to learn the techniques of those artists. They will "meet" Georgia O'Keefe, Henri Moore, Michelangelo, and the Artist within the child. The children will draw and paint while lying on their backs like Michelangelo. They will sculpt with clay, color and paint large flowers like Georgia O'Keefe and create a sculpture. Parent Volunteers are needed and welcome this year.

Bluebird's 5 Senses Science Workshop...



On March 22nd, the children in the Bluebird classes will participate in the "5 Senses Workshop". At the workshop the children will visit five hands-on stations. At each station the children will have the opportunity to use their 5 senses and experience what it would be like if one of their senses did not work. For instance, the children will see and feel Braille, they will
