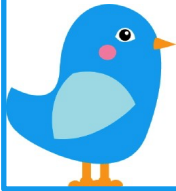

Science Experiments:

Making Slime:

The children will begin by combining glue and water in a bowl, stirring until it forms a smooth, homogenous mixture. Afterward, we'll add food coloring and glitter for fun. Finally, they'll mix in liquid starch, stirring until the slime becomes thick and stretchy. We're sure to have loads of fun with this gooey October slime!

Dancing Ghost:

The children will create a dancing ghost using static electricity from a balloon! When they rub the balloon against their hair, invisible electrons (with a negative charge) build up on the balloon's surface. These electrons will attract positively charged objects, like our tissue-paper ghost, making it "dance" in the air!

Pumpkin Prediction:

In this activity, the children will study a pumpkin scientifically, observing its weight, size, and the number of lines on it. They'll make predictions and draw conclusions based on their observations.

Shapes We Will Explore

With the teacher's guidance, the children will draw and cut out a diamond shape to create a model of Benjamin Franklin's kite, complete with a key attached to the string!
