Hickety, Pickety, Our Red Hens






Cardinal Café

Throughout the year the children have been developing their fine motor skills while gluing, beading, lacing and using a wide variety of manipulatives. During May they will be working on weaving and sewing projects while learning about basic construction. Weaving is probably the oldest elemental skill used, known to man. It is commonly used in all cultures worldwide. The children will learn that their blankets, rugs and clothing are woven. Spiders weave their webs and birds build their nest using weaving techniques. Through this project they will learn to see and understand patterns, position, and design. In the meantime, they understand process, and have fun experimenting and creating.
