

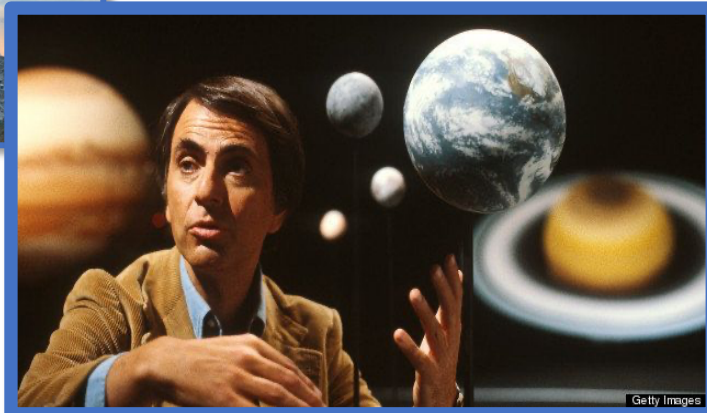

Scientist of the Month – Carl Sagan



Carl Sagan was born in New York in 1934. When he was four, his parents took him to the 1939 New York World's Fair. This became a turning point in his life and little Sagan developed an early interest in skyscrapers, science, space and the stars. His parents encouraged his growing interest in science by gifting him chemistry sets and books. After graduating from Rahway High School, NJ in 1951, he wrote several books on Space and had a TV series called Cosmos which helped many to become interested in Space. Sagan also contributed insights helping other scientist to understand the atmospheres of Venus and Jupiter, as well as seasonal changes on Mars.
