WHAT'S "WHISTLING" IN THE CARDINAL CLASS MAY Science What melts in the sun?: You may have noticed temperatures increasing and daylight Getting Longer. With more sunny days it's a great time to test out what melts in the sun. All solids have a melting point, and that temperature is different for everything. We pick several items to put in the sun and see what happens. What will happen to the raisins when you mix them with 7-Up? Raisins are denser than the liquid in the soda, so initially they sink to the bottom of the glass. The carbonated soft drink releases carbon dioxide bubbles. When these bubbles stick to the rough surface of a raisin, the raisin is lifted because of the increase in buoyancy. Dancing Raisins Experiment!
