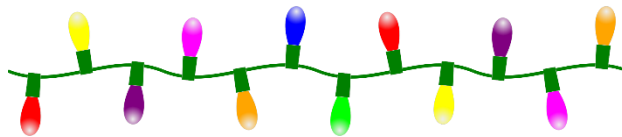
You may also **call the school phone (732-893-8222)** to listen to the recorded message.
