Fire Prevention Month

During Sing Time, the children will have an exciting visit from a Firefighter! To prepare for the visit we will talk about fire safety. Through lessons and stories, we will learn the steps to take if the children smell smoke or see a fire, calling 911, stop-drop-roll and covering your faces and planning a meeting place. Our visitor will discuss fire safety strategies with the children will also bring his Fire Truck. He will also describe the equipment a firefighter wears, explaining each piece of apparatus. This is important for the children to see because a firefighter with a facemask and oxygen tank can be very frightening. he will explain, "If someone looking like this comes up to you during a fire do not hide, he is there to help you." The children will have the opportunity to ask any questions they may have about his gear. The children will also have the opportunity to tour the Fire Truck! We are very grateful to our Firefighter for coming to demonstrate these lifesaving skills to our precious students.

Influenza Vaccine: Children 6 months through 59 months attending any childcare or preschool facility must annually receive at least one dose of influenza vaccine between September 1 & December 31 each year. It is very important you comply with this state mandate. The state sends a nurse to the Giving Nest and all preschools to check each child's medical paperwork and ascertain all shots have been administered. If shots are not up to date the child may have to leave the school. The state nurse checks all immunizations.
