KINDNESS JAR

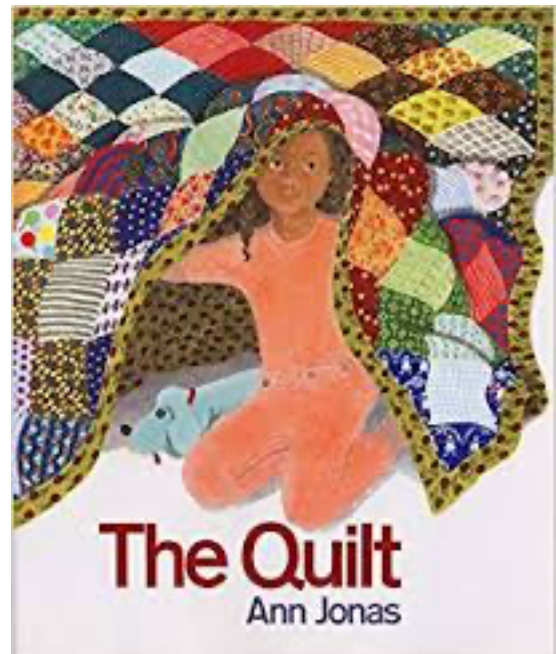
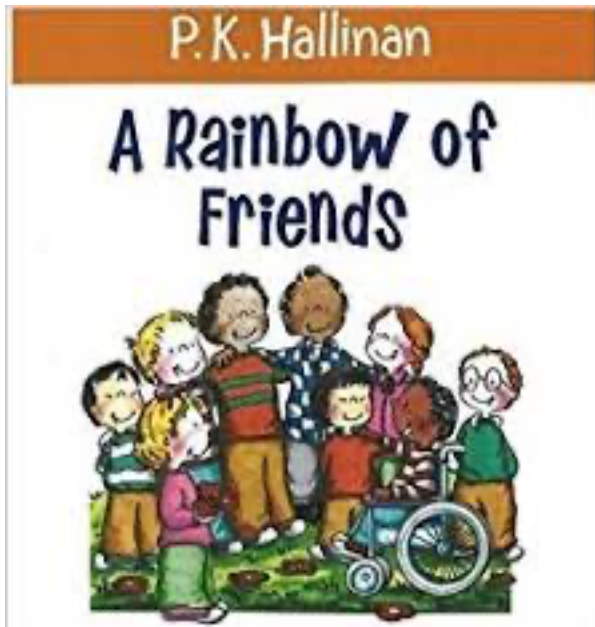
Together the class will decorate 2 jars. One will have cotton balls on the outside and one sandpaper on the outside. Kind words and deeds are soft and fluffy like cotton balls. Not kind words are abrasive like sandpaper. When a child does or says something kind the teacher will ask the child to put a cotton ball in the kindness jar. If the teacher hears a not kind word or action she will remove a cotton ball and put it in the sandpaper jar. The goal is to fill the kindness jar to the top with cotton balls by the end of the year.
