Here's What we're learning this month:

Literacy:

- Sounding out words in your head and saying the whole word aloud
- Sounds of C (When C says "K" or "S")
- Reading words with long vowels (CVCe pattern- Magic e at the end makes the other vowel say its name)
- Reading Sight Words and using them in sentences
- Story parts: Focusing on beginning , middle, and end
- Fiction/ non fiction (Real/ make believe)

Math:

- Identifying and writing #s 0-100
- Fact families (How to make 5: e.g. 1+4, 2+3. 0+5)
- Comparing numbers (more/less using symbols > <)
- Coins: counting pennies, nickels , dimes, quarters

Science/ Social Studies:

- Rainbows
- Force & Motion
- St. Patrick's Day

A Note from your Teacher

After report cards go out, please feel free to reach out if you would like a conference. The kids have been working hard to read our little books in school. I encourage you to find simple phonics books that interest them and to read a book before bedtime. Short vowel books will support what they already know! We will start learning patterns for words that have long vowel sounds. These words typically have 2- vowel, with the first saying its name or long sound. Reading at this stage is all about finding the patterns and books that the children are interested in reading!
