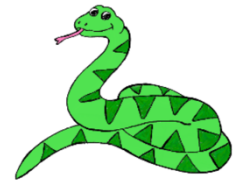
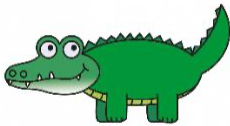

I is for Insect ... i is for iguana

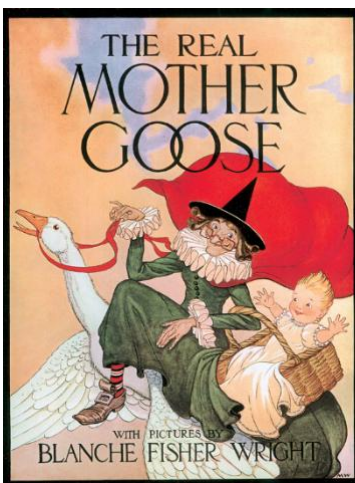

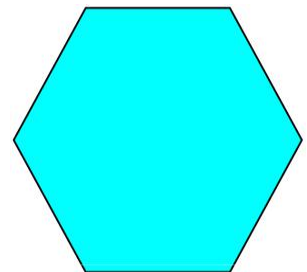
Jane Goodall teaches us to be kind to animals and to take care of our planet. 🌍🐒



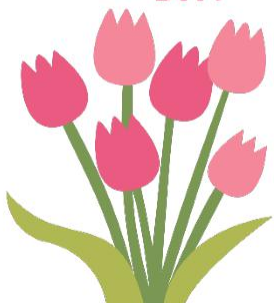
