- **February 20th & 21st - "Catch Me if You Can Day"** for the Duckling Classes only.

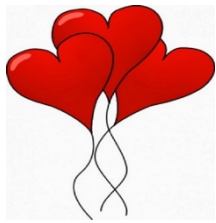

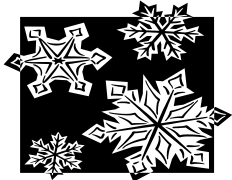
