December Science Experiments...

1. Experiment: "Follow the Bouncing Ball"

Problem: What will happen to a ping pong ball when the dryer is turned on?

Answer : When air is not moving, it pushes equally on objects from every direction. Rapidly moving air has a lower pressure. Air from the dryer moves faster around the sides of the ball than the still air does on top. Therefore, the ball seems to float above the dryer!

2. Experiment: "Tippy"

Hypothesis: What will happen when a glass filled with water has a piece of cardboard slid over the top and is then tipped over?

Answer: The cardboard will stay in place because of air pressure pushing up from the outside. This pressure is greater than the weight of the water pushing down on the cardboard from the outside. .
