### **An Ounce of Prevention is worth a pound of cure...**

Spring is a beautiful time of year, filled with outside play at playgrounds, ball fields, parks, etc. Unfortunately, it is also a time for pesky insects such as mosquitos and ticks. Both commonly live in humid environments typically in grassy and wooded areas.

Prevention techniques such as repellents on skin and clothes and daily checks are important tools for parents. Here, at school our property is treated annually but we still recommend that you check your children every night at bath time. Common places for ticks can be the back of neck, the waistline, under the arms, behind the knee, ears or anywhere on the scalp.

Combing his hair??*


*Did you ever see a llama
