WELCOME! ~September 2022~





What an exciting time of year! Your children are experiencing their first days of preschool and you as parents are full of pride and emotions wondering how this day came so fast! Our staff has been planning all summer to create a fun filled, nurturing and safe environment for our incoming students! Singing songs, meeting new friends, sharing toys, being kind to others, arts, crafts, and story time are just some of the wonderful ways we will fill our days!

The first days of school can be exciting, but for some of our little ones leaving Mommy or Daddy for the first time can be a bit unsettling. Our staff is prepared and trained to care for the crying child in a calm and loving manner. Saying goodbye can be difficult if your child is sad, but we ask you honor our "Hug and Go Zone" when dropping off your child. Meaning: a quick firm hug & kiss and a cheerful farewell sends your child a clear message that you are comfortable and happy they are in school. Although this can be hard to do as a parent, this process on a consistent basis has proven to be the best approach to minimize tear time after you leave.

When you arrive, you and your child will join the line outside and graciously wait your turn to be greeted by the teacher at the door. Please note: Chickadees will be greeted at the front entrance doors and Hummingbirds will be greeted at the side door on the right side of the building. Once the teacher has greeted you and completed the visual health check; the teacher will take your child inside where the assistants are waiting with open arms and fun toys to greet him/her! Remember, children thrive on consistency so I am certain that after a few short days, this will quickly become a routine and the children will adjust to this way of beginning their day at school.

Quite often a crying child immediately gets involved and is happy, while you may still be wondering if they are sad. Please do not hesitate to give us a call to see how your child is doing. **732-893-8222**
