**In-House Registration...** Registration Packets have been sent home in your child's folder. Be sure to return all your paperwork no later than February 1st to secure your child's spot.

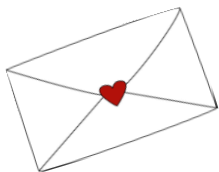


### Saying Thank You and Feeling Grateful:

This month, we hope, with your help, to encourage our students to consciously think about being grateful and going out of their way to say thank you to teachers, family members and friends. Along with reminding the children to say thank you in obvious situations we will discuss what it means to be a genuinely grateful person and to have a grateful heart. We will encourage the children to look around and notice the small, everyday things people do for them and then suggest they say thank you for these things. Examples would be when mommy washes your clothes or daddy reads you a story or grandma buckles you in the car seat or a classmate helps you with a puzzle piece or a teacher helps you find your gloves.



**Grateful Hearts...** On February 5<sup>th</sup> or 6<sup>th</sup> your child will receive a Pink "Heart" from their teacher. This is a lesson reminding children to say, "Thank You" and what it means to be grateful. Have your child tell you about someone they are grateful for at the Giving Nest. Write down the name of the person on the heart and the reason they are being thanked. It can be a classmate, teacher, someone's mom, aftercare helpers, office staff, etc. Your child will bring their heart to school and Mrs. Amy will read what is written on the hearts during Morning Sing and then place it on our wall in the entranceway for all to share and read.



**A Valentine Surprise!** The children will also be making special Valentine cards and mailing them home to their families. Parents: please provide a postage stamp on the white envelope we send home on February 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup>. The envelope will be provided for you. Please address the envelope to you and your family, with your child's help, affix the stamp and return it to school. The children love knowing that their Valentine's Day card will go to the post office, and then will be delivered to their home address, and they anxiously wait for its arrival.

### Duckling Gingerbread Day!

**Run, run as fast as you can; You can't catch me, I'm the Gingerbread Man!** Come prepared to have fun! The Giving Nest Duckling Class invites you to come for one hour of storytelling, singing, and crafting. The central theme of the party will be the story:



"The Gingerbread Man." Check your child's class calendar to see what day his/her class is scheduled. And be sure to return the response card that is sent home in your child's folder so we know who will be attending. We invite one guest per student.



### Valentine's Day and Preschool Students --- Perfect Together ---

Parties, Treats, Valentine cards and Valentine games abound at the Giving Nest in February. Please take a few minutes and read your child's February What's Up. It will explain what you need to do to make certain your child has everything he/she needs to make and send Valentine's to share with classmates. Please check your child's individual calendars to see when his/her party is scheduled. ### Valentine's love... Sharing Valentine's Day Cards with our classmates:



We **LOVE** celebrating Valentine's Day at the Giving Nest! On the day of your child's class party please send in Valentine's cards for all the children in the class.

**Chickadees and Duckling** parents should sign their child's name on the inside of the card and leave the outside envelope blank. This way your children can 'deliver' their own cards without having to read names on the outside.

**Bluebird and Cardinal children** should address envelopes with their classmates' names and sign their names on the inside of each card. These children have begun to recognize each other's names and will have fun delivering their Valentine's themselves. Of course, the teacher will assist any child that needs help.

**Kindergarten** children should also address envelopes with their classmates' names and sign their name on each card.

## President's Day



We will meet the Presidents of the United States and learn some interesting facts about many of the presidents! The children will learn a silly song about Bubble Gum that teaches money names: penny, nickel, dime, quarter, and dollar.

## February Weather and Healthy Habits...



- Weather and temperature permitting, the teachers will take the children outside, even if for a short walk.
- With this in mind, please dress your children for outside play every day (warm jacket, hat, mittens and a scarf).
- Make sure the extra clothes in the bottom of your child's backpack are changed for the winter season.
- Encourage healthy eating habits-drinking water and eating more vegetables (carrots, celery, cucumbers) and fresh fruits (strawberries, blueberries, grapes).
- Remember to brush teeth twice a day, in the morning and before bed.
  - Encourage 8-10 hours of sleep every night.
